The P's of Prayer

Posture

Find a comfortable posture for your prayer period.

Presence

Imagine yourself in the presence of the divine.

Preparatory Prayer

Lord, direct everything during this time to your praise and service.

Petition

Ask God for what your desire

Passage

Choose the passage and read it over slowly

Place

Using your imagination, picture the scene, and place yourself in the scene.

Pause and Ponder

Pause and ponder the scene, the conversation, the events and take part in them.

Period

To conclude, have a conversation with Jesus as a friend would speak to a friend.

Then review what happened in your prayer Period.
